INTERNAL EVALUATION REPORT

Introduction

The following interview has been developed by the “Sustainable Educational Approaches to Landscape”. The purpose of this interview is to evaluate the project impact on partner’s institutions and its staff. The interview provides a numerical rating from 1 (weak) to 5 (great).

After the administration of 6 internal evaluation questionnaires to people who belonging to the Comunità Montana Aventino Medio Sangro (ITALY), we indicate the results obtained:

The first question that asks **“Please, rate how much this project has improved the skills of your organization”**, 16.6% answered **5**, 33.3% answered **4**, 33.3% answered **3**, 0% answered **2**, 16.6% answered **1**.

The second question that asks: **“Please, rate how much this project has improved your personal development skill”**, 33.3% answered **5**, 50% answered **4**, 16.6% answered **3**, 0% answered **2**, 0% answered **1**.

The third question that asks **“Do you think the project supported your beneficiaries?”**, 83.3% answered yes, 16.6% answered no.

The fourth question that asks **“Do you plan to use the project products/ results in the future?”**, 100% answered yes.

The fifth question that asks **“Please, rate how much the innovative use of ICT tools is/ will be useful for you and for your beneficiaries/ stakeholders?”**, 16.6% answered **5**, 50% answered **4**, 16.6% answered **3**, 16.6% answered **2**, 0% answered **1**.

The sixth question that asks **“Please, rate how much this project has improved your skills/ knowledge about European Landscape Convention?”**, 33.3% answered **5**, 33.3% answered **4**, 33.3% answered **3**, 0% answered **2**, 0% answered **1**.

The seventh question that asks **“Please, rate how successful the partnership was?”**, 66.6% answered **5**, 16.6% answered **4**, 16.6% answered **3**, 0% answered **2**, 0% answered **1**.

Conclusion and recommendations

The scenario designated by the internal evaluation questionnaire is as follows.

We can affirm that the project impact on partner's institutions and its staff has been quite positive. The institution's skills have been certainly improved so as personal development skills. The results and the products obtained from the project will be used locally to active citizenship, promote cultural heritage, and promote environmental protection. We think that for sure the project has improved and will improve the knowledge about European Landscape Convention.
