- Very good German language skills (advanced level)
- Studies in a higher term or degree qualified (German language and literature studies, science of arts, journalism, cultural administration or comparable studies)

Exciting tasks within a young team in Berlin's international artistic environment are awaiting you. Principal language is German but communication in English is possible, too, as needed.
